Fundamental sports skills:

 Age appropriate skills programming

Fundamental hockey skills:
Basic overall game skills
Skills in combination over time



Cross-ice hockey:

- 2 games and a skills area
- * 2 games and a rest area

The Dangers of Early Sport Specialization



Every year, more than 3.5 million children under age fifteen require medical treatment for sports injuries, nearly half of which are the result of simple overuse.



KEYS TO EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION AT THE IP LEVEL.



- 1. Use age appropriate language (TOUGH TO DO!)
- 2. Teach on thing- NOT 3 THINGS!
- 3. Build in Praise whenever possible.
- Tell them what they will be doing, let them try it, then ask them what they just did (AN OLD TEACHING AXIOM)
- 5. Never underestimate the importance of vision with respect to long term learning. (coaches boards, video clips, demonstrations)
