Position Description

Duties/Activities/Responsibilities:

- Provide input in the evaluation/selection of the team players
- Provide input to and assist with the execution of the practice plans
- Time the line shifts during the games, help the players on and off the ice during games
- Assist with supplies needed for practices and games (jersey/pucks/pylons, etc.)
- Support the Head Coach in all facets
- Assistant Coaches are expected to adhere to the Hockey Canada Mission Statement and BGHA's Belief Statements and their Respect in Sport/Speak Out designation.

Time Commitment:

- The Assistant Coach is expected to attend all team events including practices, games (exhibition, regular season, tournament and playoffs) and team sanctioned events or advice the Head Coach in advance to ensure adequate coverage is present.
- Head Coaches and Assistant Coaches, or designate, are expected to allocate sufficient time before and after games and practices and allow for adequate supervision
- 1-2 games per week (home and/or away), one practice per week, at least one tournament per season and end of year Banquet.
- Support Head Coach by attending all team staff meetings and parent meetings.

Location:

- The majority of the coaching responsibilities will occur at the Brantford Girls Hockey Association home ice, which is the Wayne Gretzky Sports Centre. Secondary locations are Lion's Park Arena and the Brant Sports Complex.
- The Assistant Coach (or designate) will be required to travel to other centers to participate in all games, attend training sessions or information meetings as required by the BGHA Executive. NOTE: Some games <u>may</u> involve US travel for League Play.

Orientation and Training:

- Continue professional development with the approval of the Representative Director
- Coaching resources within the BGHA Website
- May be required to attend Coach Meetings
